Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next four years to 8 tCO₂e by 2026. This is a reduction of 55%

Carbon Reduction Projects to be implemented include:

- Reduce. Reuse, Recycle – Encourage staff to use less paper products, packaging and use reusable drink receptacles.
- Minimalise single use plastics and encourage use of biodegradable containers and compositable products.
- Print as minimally as possible – encourage use of online signing software for documents; don't print emails but save to file; use projectors for presentations instead of printing brochures.
- Advise landlord of new modern serviced office the benefits of green energy products for lighting and heating.
- Encourage staff where possible to cycle/walk and take less vehicle journeys to work. Allowance of working from home will help this.
- Updates to the travel policy mandating public transport on certain routes or the selection of greener options.
- Hold a meeting to update staff to all the available carbon footprint reduction initiatives available and to teach them why the need to reduce our carbon footprint is so important.

Carbon Reduction Projects

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

Committing further to helping in the local community with planting trees to encourage the teaching/encouraging the younger generations on the importance of reducing their carbon footprint
